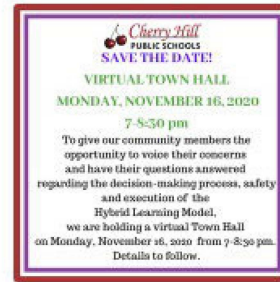


Minute with Dr. Meloche - World Kindness Day Edition

This "Minute" discusses the challenges of the past week and includes important information about an upcoming virtual Community Town Hall.

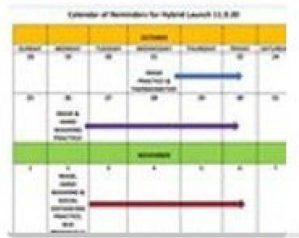
Virtual Town Hall about Hybrid Learning Model to be Held 11/16/20

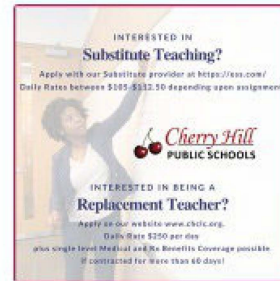
