Hybrid Model Class Times Set; Opportunity Available to Change Choice of Hybrid vs. Full Remote

As explained in today's 10/16/20 Minute with Dr. Meloche above, class times for the Hybrid Learning Model, with part in-person instruction/part remote instruction, are now set for the launch of the hybrid model on November 9, 2020. <u>Graphics explaining the schedules are available on the WE Return to Learn page of the District website</u>.

Please note that busing times for elementary and middle school students participating in the hybrid model will follow the usual morning pickup times and early dismissal afternoon times. Busing times for high school students participating in the hybrid model will change in accordance with their starting and ending times. High school families will find their new bus times in their Genesis accounts on Wednesday, October 21, 2020.

Families who wish to change from their originally chosen learning model, whether hybrid or full remote, may do so by contacting the <u>appropriate designated administrator at their school, listed online</u>. The deadline for changing a student's chosen learning model is Thursday, October 22, 2020.
