Increase to 7 Free Meals Per Student, Per Week Begins 10/5/20

We are pleased to announce that the number of meals distributed to ALL STUDENTS IN CHERRY HILL will increase from five to seven per student each week beginning October 5, 2020 at High Schools East & West. Each Monday from 3-6 pm, each student will receive 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches; each Wednesday from 3-6 pm, each student will receive 4 breakfasts and 4 lunches. This program will continue through December 31, 2020 or until the federal funds for the program run out.

IMPORTANT: Apply for Free/Reduced-Price Meals by OCTOBER 15 DEADLINE Before Free Meal Distribution Ends

Because our free meal distribution will end by December 31 – or "until the funds run out" – families are encouraged to apply now for Free and Reduced Price Meals for the 2020-2021 school year. **Deadline** is **October 15, 2020**. A letter of explanation in **English** and in **Spanish** is available to interested families.

For the fastest response, we strongly encourage families to apply online.
