Distribution of Free Meals for All Cherry Hill Students Extended

The USDA has extended the District's ability to distribute FREE MEALS TO ALL CHERRY HILL STUDENTS through December 31, 2020 "or until the funds run out." Distribution begins after Labor Day. On September 8, 2020 distribution will take place from 2-6 pm at High Schools East and West. Beginning September 14: Mondays and Wednesdays from 3-6 pm at East and West. Please note that the distribution schedule may be adjusted the week of September 28 due to the holiday.
