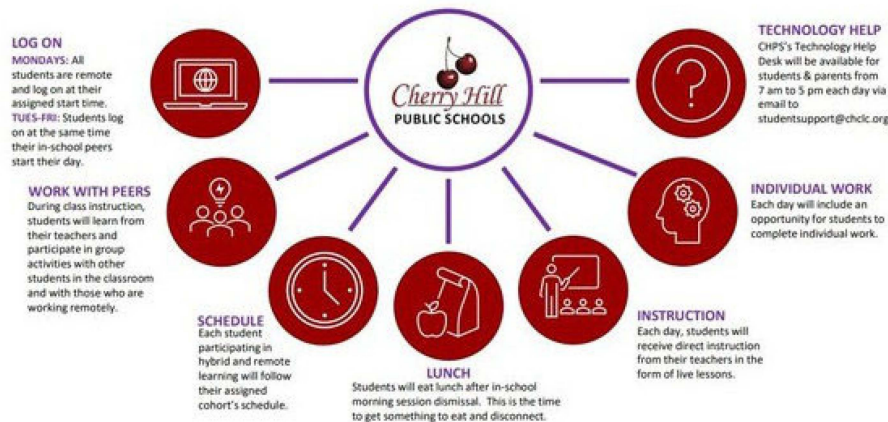

Learning Schedules Explained

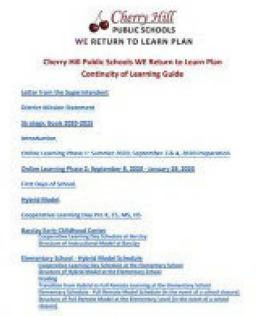

Continuity of Learning Plan Updated to Include Guidance on COVID-19 Illness
