Free Grab & Go Breakfasts and Lunches Now Offered to All Cherry Hill Students Under Age 18

As explained in the Minute with Dr. Meloche above, grab and go breakfasts and lunches will be available to ALL CHERRY HILL STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 for the remainder of our COVID-19 closure mandated by Gov. Phil Murphy to continue through at least May 15. Each Monday, students will receive 2 breakfasts and 2 lunches per student. Each Wednesday, students will receive 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches per student. Choose pickup location: Cherry Hill High School East, Cherry Hill High School West or Clara Barton Elementary from 10 am-noon. Please be sure to have proof of Cherry Hill residence, such as your driver's license with Cherry Hill address, or student ID numbers ready in order to claim each student's meal. Questions? The Cherry Hill Public Schools Budget was adopted on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 after the Board of Education's annual Budget Hearing discussion. These highlights include the progress that has been made in the district during the past four years, such as the additional positions of Technology Coach; 2 ESL Teachers; Floating Nurse (working in any building as needed); Director of Compliance/Equity, including Affirmative Action/HIB; Human Resources position; and contracted Grant Writer.
