Highlights from the August 2018 Action Meeting

Board Representative Reports

Cherry Hill High School East Representative Julia Langmuir delivered a brief update regarding High School East. Ms. Langmuir noted that roof repairs to fix leaks in the auditorium were wrapping up at the school. She noted that several Township-sponsored workshops and classes had taken place at the school over the summer. These activities now are replaced with sports and marching band practice. She added that this Thursday, August 30, would be New Student Orientation Day, with tours and a Q&A session. Ms. Langmuir closed her comments by saying the students are looking forward to another great year.

Neither the Cherry Hill High School West Representative nor Alternate were present at the meeting to deliver a report.

Curriculum & Instruction

The Board approved attendance at conferences and workshops for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board approved the Nursing Standing Orders for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board approved out of district student placements for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board approved the Agreement for the 2018/2019 School Year – Resolution to Correct Previous Motion on June 26, 2018– Contract Amount

The Board approved a Resolution Approving a Services Agreement between the Board and Epic Developmental Services to Provide Behavioral Therapy and Consultation Services.

The Board approved a Resolution Approving a Professional Services Agreement between the Cherry Hill Board of Education and EI US, LLC to Provide Homebound Services.

The Board approved Readopting Curriculum.

Business & Facilities

The Board approved financial reports for June 2018, including the Board Secretary's Certification and Treasurer's Report, the Line Item Transfer Report, the Food Service Operating Statement, and the SACC Financial Report. The Board approved the disbursement of funds in the amount of \$2,813,305.40.

The Board approved the Bill Lists dated August 28, 2018 with the first Bill List in the amount of \$6,141.93, and the second Bill List in the amount of \$6,119,826.37.

The Board approved the SACC Bill List for August 28, 2018 in the amount of \$39,935.84.

The Board approved a Resolution for the Award of Bids for Transportation Athletics – High School, Spring 2018/2019 School Year.

The Board was informed that no bids for Library HVAC Replacement and Related Work at Carusi Middle School had come in after advertising and solicitation. No recommendation could be made as no bid proposals were received. The Board was informed that the project will be rebid.

The Board approved a Resolution for the Award of Bids for Varsity Baseball Field Backstop Netting System, Chain Link Fence Replacement and Related Work at High School West.

The Board approved multiple Resolutions for the Award of Transportation.

The Board approved a Resolution Postponing the Special Election Tentatively Set for Tuesday, October 2, 2018, and will reschedule the Special School District Election at a future available date, possibly December 11, 2018, by subsequent resolution.

Business & Facilities

The Board accepted the following donations:

A monetary anonymous donation of \$500 to Kington Elementary School to be used for a gaga pit on the playground.

A monetary donation from the Rosa PTA to Rosa Middle School for 19 Chrome Books and 46 electric pencil sharpeners: \$6,750.

A monetary donation from the Sharp PTA to Sharp Elementary School for the purchase of 3 Smart Boards: \$6,597.

A monetary donation from the Cherry Hill Education Foundation to Cherry Hill High School East for T-shirts to be used at Freshman Orientation: \$2,310.

Human Resources/Negotiations

The Board approved termination of employment and appointments of certificated staff, including teachers and long-term substitute teachers, student teachers, clinical training and co-curricular appointments.

The Board approved various appointments of non-certificated staff, leaves of absence, assignment/salary changes, and other compensation.
