
Highlights from the May 2018 Action Meeting

Presentations

The Board recognized the members of the Cherry Hill High School East Boys Tennis Team for their accomplishment as 2018 Olympic Conference American Division Champions.

Board Representative Reports

Cherry Hill High School East Representative Joshua Sodicoff reported that two of East's DECA presentations made it to the final and one ranked in the top 10 in its category in the nation at the DECA International Career Development Conference. He noted the success of the Mime Ice Cream Social and the Junior Prom during the last week of April. Mr. Sodicoff also mentioned that Senior Prom is coming up on May 31 and noted the school's formal apology for the prom ticket, which originally had the tagline "Party Like It's 1776." He noted that more careful supervision of the prom ticket production would be in place in the future. Mr. Sodicoff mentioned the upcoming graduation and Project Graduation, as well as AP testing, the One Act Play Festival and various Honor Society inductions. He also noted the spring Dodgeball Tournament and the spring music concerts, as well as spring sports. Mr. Sodicoff closed by saying he would be attending the University of Michigan and that East's Alternate Representative Lauren Atkin would attend the University of Virginia in the fall. He noted that while he begin his position as Board Representative "suspicious of local politics and thought this job would involve me making the Board accountable to the students...I didn't realize that everyone who sits on this board and works in the administration is as dedicated to improving the lives of students in this district as is humanly possible." Mr. Sodicoff noted that while he did not believe certain incidents were "handled in the best way," he believes in

some cases "blame may have been incorrectly assigned to this board." He noted, "If nothing else, we can say that these episodes have been teachable."

Cherry Hill High School West Representative Carlee Cohen gave a detailed wrap-up of the school year at West. She mentioned AP testing, Teacher Appreciation Week, the STAR (Specially Talented Athletes Recognized) Games, the Special Ed Department's annual end-of-year dance, the One Act Plays Festival, spring sports, the West Art Show, spring music concerts, the Annual World Language Department Cook-Off, juniors' science testing, and the Senior Prom and Promenade. She noted that graduation is just 28 days away.
