

Highlights from the January 2018 Action Meeting

Presentations

The Cherry Hill High School East and Cherry Hill High School West African American Culture Clubs presented a preview of the upcoming "Still Rising – A Celebration of Black History Month."

Board Representative Reports

Cherry Hill High School West Representative Carlee Cohen reported that more than 200 West DECA members competed in the Southern Gold Regional Conference on January 8, with more than 70 students qualifying for states. She noted that Phantom of the opera auditions had concluded and rehearsals had begun. She noted that the play will open March 16. Ms. Cohen also detailed the Purple Carpet Gala for the premier of a video highlighting the school's partnership with Virtua Hospital, offering students hands-on internships within the high school curriculum. She added that in sports, both the wrestling team and the bowling team were having standout seasons. Ms. Cohen also mentioned the work of Peer Leaders who visited health classes with mini lessons on improving listening. She concluded by noting that the second half of the school year was beginning.

Cherry Hill High School East Representative Joshua Sodicoff reported that the Freshman Dance was held on the first Friday of the month. He also summarized East's participation in the DECA regional competition, with several students advancing to states. Mr. Sodicoff described East's first "Unity Day" in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. He noted that the East Vocal Department had held its winter concert and that the student musicians had hosted students from Beck and Rosa Middle Schools for a day of workshops. Mr. Sodicoff also mentioned the upcoming instrumental and theater

events, including the spring musical, "The Music Man." He described the swim team's strong showing this season, as well as the winter track team's successes.

The Board approved attendance at conferences and workshops for the 2017-2018 school year.

The Board approved the Extended School year program (ESY) for 2018.

Business & Facilities
