

Highlights from the January 2017 Action Meeting

Board Representative Reports

Kaitlyn Boyle, Cherry Hill High School East Representative, reported that Cherry Hill High School East students held a Women's March at the school on January 23. She noted that the Science Team participated in the regional competition. Ms. Boyle also mentioned that the Freshman Dance had been a success and that this year's Coffee House had benefitted Jane Goodall's Roots & Shoots. The fundraiser included an opportunity to give a teacher a pie in the face. Ms. Boyle said that the East Lip Sync was scheduled for Friday, January 27. In addition, she said, the Kaleidocsope Concert would be held on February 2 with the theme, Songs from Artists in New Jersey. Ms. Boyle also mentioned that the East Orchestra would be performing at Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. She noted that East's Science National Honor Society Tour would include visits to Sharp, Cooper and Woodcrest Elementary Schools to encourage the younger students' interest in science. She also mentioned a science program enabling an East student to shadow a student at Rowan University. Ms. Boyle said the Valentine's Rose Sale would be ongoing through the Cum Laude Society. She also noted that six out of seven teams had qualified for the Robotics state competition in March, while more than 200 students from the DECA team had qualified for states. Ms. Boyle said students were happy with the new three-day PARCC schedule for high school students. She wrapped her report by mentioning debates about the controversy surrounding East's chosen spring musical, Ragtime.
