

GOVERNING BOARD MEETING MINUTES – September 15, 2021

A. Meeting Opening

Call to Order

Mr. Garcia called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Roll Call

Board Members present: Brian Garcia (President), Andres Barraza (Vice President), Berdetta Hodge (arrived at 7:00 PM), Sarah James, and Armando Montero. Absent: None.

Adoption of the Agenda

On motion of Mr. Garcia, seconded by Mrs. James and passed 4-0 (Mr. Barraza: aye; Mr. Garcia: aye; Mrs. James: aye; Mr. Montero: aye), the Governing Board approved the meeting agenda.

B. Executive Session

The Governing Board did not meet in Executive Session.

C. Presentation

C-1—Presentation of Tribal Flags

Tribal flags from the Ak-Chin Indian Community, the Gila River Indian Community, the Navaho Nation, the Pascua Yaqui Tribe, and the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community will hang in the Board Room. Dr. Mendivil said he and the Executive Team were honored to welcome tribal dignitaries and guests for the presentation. Mr. Garcia welcomed tribal members on behalf of the Governing Board. He said he appreciated the support of Ismael Osuna and Jose Saldana who spearheaded this effort. Mr. Garcia said it is our obligation to work with all tribal governments on behalf of the students we serve.

Native American Post 124 presented the colors. Ricardo Leonard, Vice President of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community, and Lemuel Vincent, Vice Chairman of the Ak-Chin Indian Community, shared blessings in their native languages and in English. Mr. Osuna explained how the flag presentation came about.

Pascua Yaqui Chairman Peter Yucupicio said that his people had to fight for the right to exist as did his brothers and sisters of the other tribes in attendance. He said for many years the Pascua Yaqui were afraid to fly their flag. They are humbled and honored to have their flag presented. Chairman Yucupicio introduced Councilwomen Catalina Alvarez, Angelina Matus, Andrea Gonzalez, and Antonia Campoy and former Councilman Luis Gonzalez.

Town of Guadalupe Mayor Valerie Molina said the flag presentation means a lot to the community and native children. It is monumental to be able to fly the colors of the Nation. She thanked the district for including Guadalupe. Vice Mayor Ricardo Vital thanked the district for allowing the community and the tribe to have a seat at the table. Mayor Molina and Vice Mayor Vital presented a gift to the district on behalf of the Pascua Yaqui tribe and the town of Guadalupe.

Gila River Indian Community Governor Stephen Lewis said having the right to wear religious tribal regalia at graduation is important to Native American students, as is honoring sovereign nationhood flags in Tempe Union's leadership room. The Governor hopes these symbolic acts will help students be proud of their identity, history, culture and tradition. He said the GRIC will look at ways it can support Native American education at Tempe Union and thanked the Board for allowing him to speak. He introduced Isaac Salcido, Director of Tribal Education.

Vice President Leonard said the maze on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community flag contains life lessons and that Tempe Union honors his people by allowing them to fly their flag in the board room. He said it was an honor to be sitting with leaders from other tribes. Vice President Leonard was accompanied by Troy

Truax and Amanda White.

Vice Chairman Vincent said he is proud to represent the Ak-Chin Community. Chairman Robert Miguel and Councilmembers Lisa Garcia, Delia Carlyle and Octavio Machado were unable to attend. He said it was an honor to sit with his brothers and sisters as a step forward for indigenous and native people. Education Director Dr. Darlene Smith-raibon said this is a momentous occasion. She thanked the district for inviting the Community and for recognizing indigenous children in the district's schools.

President Jonathan Nez of the Navajo Nation was unable to attend the tribal flag presentation.

Dr. Mendivil thanked the tribal members for allowing the district to fly their flags. Mr. Garcia said seeing his and other tribal flags recognized is monumental. He was sorry President Nez wasn't able to attend. Mr. Garcia read a statement acknowledging Tempe Union's presence on the ancestral lands of the Akimel O'odham (Pima) and Pee Posh (Maricopa) Indigenous peoples.

Mr. Garcia recessed the meeting at 6:28 PM.

D. Reconvene

Welcome—Mr. Garcia welcomed everyone at 7:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence—Mrs. James led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Garcia asked the audience for a moment of silence for Suicide Prevention Month, 9/11 families, and those lost during the pandemic.

Land Acknowledgement—Mrs. Hilgers read a statement acknowledging Tempe Union's presence on the ancestral lands of the Akimel O'odham (Pima) and Pee Posh (Maricopa) Indigenous peoples.

E. Report from Superintendent

E-1—Marcos de Niza Fire Update

Mr. McDonald said nineteen classrooms in the 100 building were impacted by the fire and restoration will take approximately 120 days.

E-2—Council of Urban Boards of Education Conference

Dr. Mendivil and Ms. Hodge are attending the CUBE conference in Atlanta. They will present a report at the meeting in October.

E-3—Family Advisory Council to Superintendent (FACS)

One of Dr. Mendivil's goals last year was the creation of a family/parent council to advise him and district leadership on ways schools and the district can provide a welcoming environment to all families, develop strong home/school partnerships, and promote the active participation of parents and families for the achievement of all students. The advisory council has been established, and information on membership is available on the district website.

F. Presentation

F-1—Boys to Men

Steve Murphy provided an overview of the Boys to Men organization. Also attending the meeting was student Aiden Odom, his grandmother, and Mountain Pointe Assistant Principal Brian Bannock. Aiden said he has been part of the group for over a year. He said he looks forward to every meeting and learns life lessons at each. Mr. Murphy answered Governing Board members' questions. Some Board members' questions/comments:

- Ms. Hodge said this is a successful program and gives boys a connection with an adult who cares about them. She will continue to support it.
- Mrs. James asked about the diversity of the mentors and how mentors are selected. *Currently 30% of the mentors are men of color while 85% of the students are boys of color. They are working with community organizations to increase the diversity in mentors. Mentors must be able to listen to the boys without judgement. All mentors must pass a background check.*
- Mr. Barraza asked how students get into the program. *Counselors and teachers do most referrals;*

- however, some parents reach out through the website. Boys have to want to be part of the program.
- Mr. Montero asked for more details on the training given to volunteers. *Workshops introduce motivational interviewing where volunteers partner with each other to ask open-ended questions. Part of the training includes learning how to actively listen.*
- Mr. Garcia thanked Aidin for sharing his story; he said the Boys to Men website has outdated statistics and data and he wants to make sure there is a correlation between the work of Boys to Men and what is already happening within Tempe Union.

H. Public Comment

The following individual(s) provided public comment:

- Sarah Waraksa, MHS parent, said her son has to quarantine for ten days because of a Covid exposure at school; said to implement a testing policy for kids who have been exposed at school and implement a wellness check in the morning; if her son is ever symptomatic he won't go to school.
- Meredith Scheerer, DV parent, said her daughter was asymptomatic with Covid and not allowed to Zoom into her classes; because she couldn't access her lessons and learn the material she got a zero and two F's; said to allow parents to make the decision if their child is well enough to learn.

Mr. Garcia asked Dr. Mendivil to look into Ms. Scheerer's comment.
