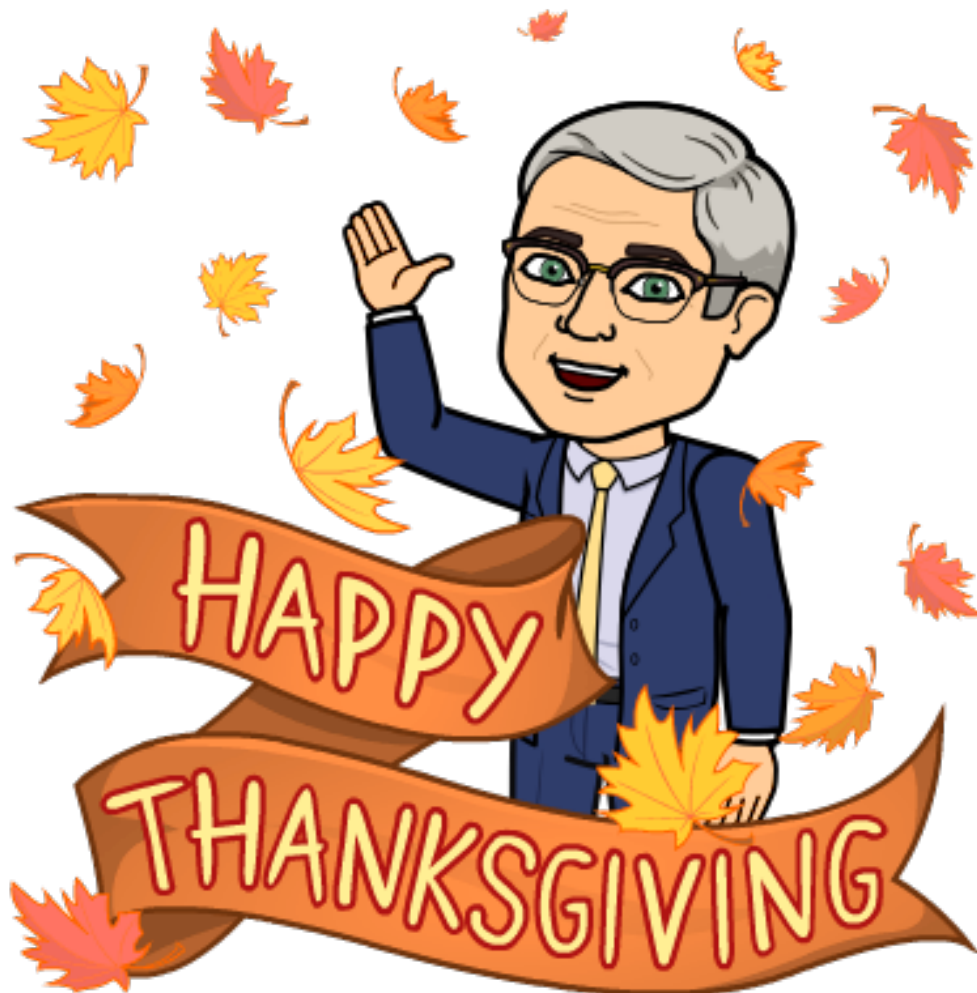


A message from the Superintendent of the Cherry Hill Public Schools.

Those selected will receive:

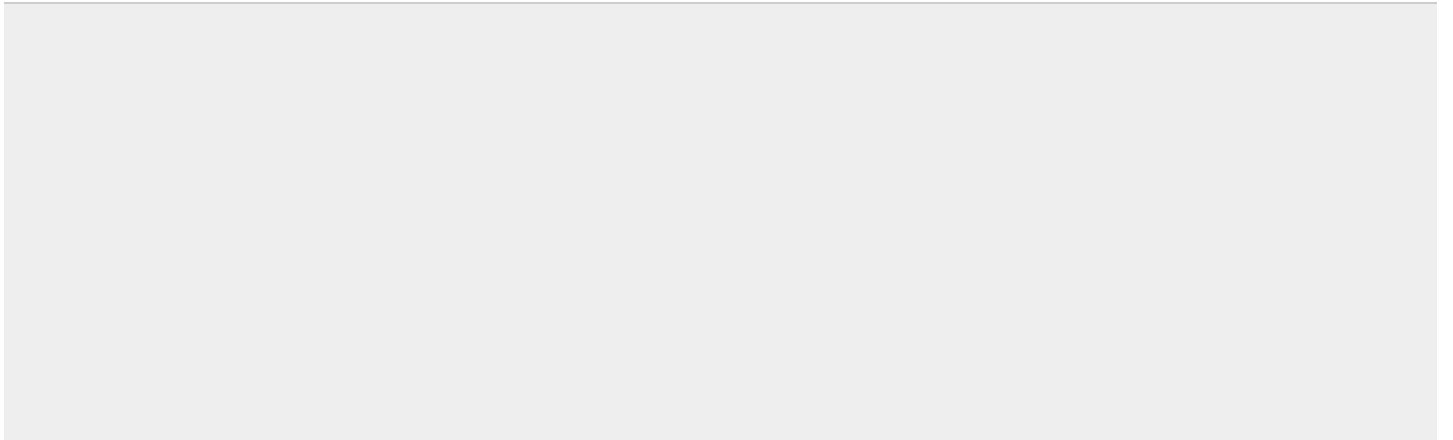
- A medal of Recognition;
