# WELCOME to the New Year!

School opens on Tuesday, September 3, 2019.

Happy New Year – New *School* Year, that is! Our administrators, technology team, registration department, business office, transportation department, secretaries, buildings and grounds staff, and custodial staff have been working throughout the summer to prepare for the best day of the year: the first day of school, when our students return and fill our buildings with excitement, curiosity and positive energy!

I would like to thank all of the above-mentioned folks for their hard work and dedication. We would not be able to open without their efforts. When you see them at school, please share your thanks for all that they do for our district.

Also this summer, there has been a great deal of discussion and media coverage regarding the Board of Education discussion about Board Policy 8550 – Unpaid Meal Charges/Outstanding Food Service Charges. As of the first day of school, September 3, 2019, the following procedures will be followed:

- All children who want a school lunch will continue to be served lunch, regardless of the balance in their meal account
- Children whose accounts are in arrears may choose the meal they desire, but they will not be able to buy a la carte items

The Board will continue its discussion on Policy 8550 at the next Board of Education meeting on September 10, 2019 at 7 pm in the Malberg Administration Building Board Room.

In the meantime, <u>I have sent a letter to New Jersey</u> <u>Governor Phil Murphy</u> imploring him to insist on legislation that removes <u>the State-mandated language</u> requiring the withholding of meals as part of the policy.
