Discussion on Unpaid Meal Charges

A letter to the CHPS community from Superintendent Dr. Joseph Meloche and Board of Education President Eric Goodwin.

The end of August and the waning days of summer are filled with excitement and anticipation as school is about to begin. On Tuesday, September 3, we will welcome more than 11,000 students to our 19 schools, including our first class of full day kindergarten students across the district. There have been many new families to meet in the registration office and even more eager children on the playgrounds at our schools ready for the year to begin. This year, there have also been many discussions regarding overdue balances for breakfast & lunch in our schools. While the most recent discussion was initiated at the Board of Education Meeting on August 13, 2019, there has been ongoing discussion in our district about this issue for the past two years. This time, however, the discussion spread onto social media and into the press.

Unfortunately, what has been lost in many of the discussions, on Facebook and in the press, is the complexity of this issue and the legal requirements of New Jersey State Statute 18A:33-21.

A detailed explanation of the unpaid meals issue has been posted to the District web site. I encourage you to read the letter, from Board President Mr. Eric Goodwin and me, to gain a full understanding of the foundation of what the Board of Education will be discussing at the BOE meeting on Tuesday, August 27 at 7 pm. Please note that the location of the meeting will be the John A. Carusi Middle School cafeteria at 315 Roosevelt Drive.

Just a week after that meeting, school opens! The first day of school for all students, September 3, 2019, is an early dismissal day for elementary students only. Elementary students will be dismissed at 1 pm on September 3.
