Kilmer Elementary Holds 13th Annual Alex's Lemonade Stand

Joyce Kilmer Elementary School on Friday, May 24, 2019, held its <u>13th Annual</u> <u>Alex's Lemonade Stand</u> to raise money for childhood cancer research.

During the past 12 years, Kilmer has raised \$44,654 for the charity. Last year's event, pictured above, brought in \$3,925; this year's goal is \$5,350 in the hopes of reaching a grand total \$50,000 since 2007! In 2017, Kilmer received an award for being one of the top fundraisers out of approximately 12,000 stands. In 2010 the school was awarded as a "Top 100 Stand Host."

This year's event will be held in honor of Kilmer Alum Owen Dodd, as the community celebrates 10 years of his good health after the removal of a brain tumor.
