WE can't wait to grab the opportunities to socialize, do good deeds for our earth, support our athletes and raise funds for our schools this weekend!

It's been my great pleasure to welcome back students and staff this week after our 10-day Spring Break! Our buildings have been humming with activity all week, with many of our students and staff preparing for the exciting happenings this weekend.

Tomorrow, Saturday, May 4, we have two fantastic events - one that's an annual favorite, and one that's brand new. The 10th annual Sustainable South Jersey Earth Festival (formerly the Cherry Hill Earth Festival) will take place from 10 am to 2 pm at Croft Farm, with a family bike ride before the festival at 9 am (check-in at 8:30). If you've never been to the Earth Festival, be sure to take the whole family. It's a wonderfully informational and fun day in which all of our schools participate. Rosa Middle School's vocal groups will kick off the opening ceremony at about 9:45. All 19 of our schools will have displays about their students' sustainability work, including a working water filtration system produced by Cherry Hill High School West and a performance by Stockton Elementary students' "Upcycle Orchestra," in which students will play instruments they made from discarded plastic and other items! Our own mascots from West and East -Westley the Lion and Crimson the Cougar - will be there from 10 until noon for photo ops. Other student musical and performance groups will take the stage throughout the day. There will be food and vendors, opportunities for recycling household items, and more.
