More CHPS alumni came to West on March 21 as the cast and crew of *Chicago* put on a great "preview" matinee show for our community's senior citizens, followed by a lunch prepared by West's Advanced Culinary Arts students. The delighted crowd marveled at our students' talents on stage and off, saying they can't wait to see what these students accomplish as they become alumni themselves. We can't either!


Enrollment for Summer Enrichment Camp Program Now Open
