Women's History Month

Today is International Women's Day, part of Women's History Month for the Month of March. WE celebrate those around us who have made or are on the verge of making history!

We're now one week into March, and one week into Women's History Month, which is being celebrated internationally and in our schools. Rosa International Middle School 6th and 7th grade students, for example, are broadcasting daily presentations on R-TV, the school's television news program, about women who have created world-changing inventions and discoveries. Other schools have put up showcase displays and bulletin boards, have integrated women's history into daily lessons, and will have guest speakers throughout the month.

And **WE** don't have to look far to find women and girls who have made or are making history – they are right here in the Cherry Hill Public Schools. Eleven girls at Cherry Hill High School West <u>made history this year as one of South Jersey's largest contingents of high school girl wrestlers</u> since the sport was officially sanctioned for female students by the New Jersey
