Full day kindergarten will be in place across all CHPS elementary schools beginning with the 2019-2020 school year! We invite the community to learn more, beginning next week.

As CHPS Director of Curriculum, it's been wonderful for me these past several months to be a part of the development of the Cherry Hill Public Schools' new full day kindergarten program, coming to all of our elementary schools at the start of the 2019-2020 school year. I've had the pleasure of working with the Kindergarten Committee, a dedicated group of 27 volunteers with a variety of professional and personal expertise in kindergarten education. Together with the District Curriculum Department and the Board of Education Curriculum and Instruction Committee, we have crafted a standout program that includes expanded play-based learning, free play time, attention to social/emotional learning, and dedicated "encore classes" classes such as music, library and art. Our research in the formulation of the full day curriculum included visits to other districts with full day kindergarten programs of their own. The enthusiasm for our new program among our committee, our parents, our teachers and administrators has remained strong throughout this process. The result is an innovative, comprehensive program, dedicated to excellence.


