Full Day Kindergarten Update

Many parents have been asking what's happening with our plan for full day kindergarten. It's a go for 2019-2020!

Amazingly, only this week have we completed a full, five-day week of school since opening day on September 5! As I've been out and about, I've seen how well our students have hit their stride in the classroom, on the athletic fields, and in their other extracurricular activities. We've wrapped up our Back to School Nights. Our teachers and administrators have a true feel for the "personalities" of their classes at every grade level. And as always, we continue to look to the future, to ways to continue to grow and improve.

With that same eye on the future, several parents have been in touch with us, whether through our Quick Question portal or through calls and emails, asking about full day kindergarten. We've posted a "Minute with Dr. Meloche" video – featuring our friends from Sharp Elementary School, pictured above – with a full day kindergarten update today to our Instragram, Facebook and Twitter platforms. I'd like to expand on that information a bit:

- Full day kindergarten will start on the first day of school of the 2019-2020 school year.
- Full day kindergarten will operate in each one of our elementary schools. The full day program will replace the current half day program.
- Full day kindergarten is budgeted in our regular operating budget. It is not dependent on the bond referendum vote on December 11, 2018.
- Our kindergarten curriculum committee is diligently working on the curriculum.
