Making Your Voice Heard

WE welcome and value input from our community. Here's how to make sure your communication with us is effective.

Now that we are halfway into September – yet marking only the sixth day of school – our Back to School nights are well underway and our students are getting into the groove of classes, sports and other activities. I would like to thank you for your patience as we work out the kinks in our transportation and pick up/drop off procedures, among other adjustments typical with the beginning of a new school year.

As you likely have seen in media coverage and perhaps on social media discussion, we have dealt with mold cleanup this fall at Cherry Hill High School East. We are one among many districts in the South Jersey/Philadelphia area that found mold in classrooms after our wet, humid summer. We are fortunate to have alert, trained staff who found the mold and reported it immediately, allowing us to conduct a quick cleanup and thorough testing to ensure no affected classroom was reopened until cleared to do so by our environmental specialist, TTI Environmental Corporation.

Whenever there is a concern in our schools, we encourage staff, students and/or parents to bring it to our attention. In order to address issues effectively, we ask that certain communication protocols are followed:

- If the issue is regarding transportation, please call our transportation office (856) 489-5851 or the transportation hotline at (856) 761-1092. Our staff in the transportation office can assist you with information about bus delays and bus stop assignments.
- For school-related concerns, start at the building level. If there is a concern about

After November 1, our new Assistant Superintendent/K-12, Dr. Justin Smith, will be the point of contact after you speak with the building principals.

Previous questions and answers also are posted on the Quick Question page, so you may find an answer to your question there without having to submit it!
