Stay tuned for more details on the classroom makeover, which also includes furniture and technology supplied by Hon Furniture and SMART/TEQ!

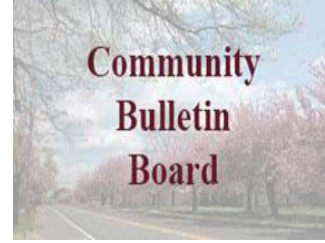

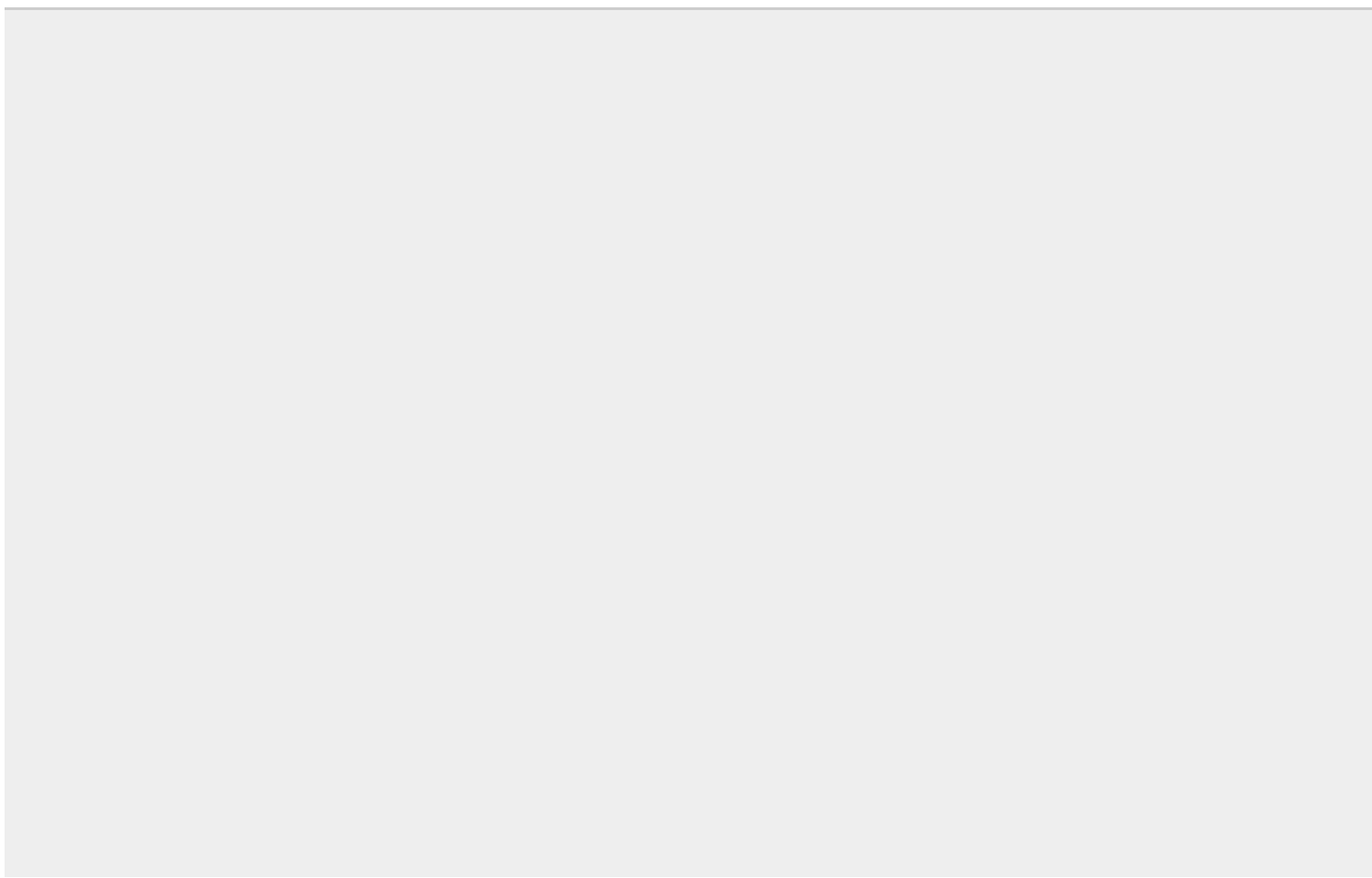
