Group, Stay Tuned, Earns Multiple Honors

Cherry Hill High School East's a cappella vocal ensemble, Stay Tuned, has wrapped up a successful 2015-16 performance and competition season.

In January, East's vocal department hosted the International Competition of High School A Cappella (ICHSA) Quarter Finals, attended by more than 1,000 music fans. Stay Tuned took second place, advancing to the Semi-Finals, which were hosted by Pitch Slapped realty show rivals Highlands Voices from Highlands High School. In the semi-finals, Stay Tuned placed second in a field of eight of the top a cappella groups in the Mid-Atlantic region.

In March, Deke Sharon, their Pitch Slapped mentor, invited Stay Tuned to perform as a featured ensemble alongside stars from the Pitch Perfect movies and a cappella groups from all over the world. One week later, Stay Tuned were featured quest performers at the International Competition of College A Cappella (ICCA) Semi-Finals at the Kimmel Center in Philadelphia where they wowed the sold out audience and college performing groups with their performance.

Stay Tuned finished the competition season taking first place in Moorestown High School's "A Cappella for Autism." They also won the award for Best Choreography. Senior Doobee Synn and junior Jeff Wang won the award for Best Vocal Percussion.

Showings at Penn Relays

Congratulations to the Rosa International Middle School boys 4 x 100 meter relay team, who won the Penn Relays South Jersey Championship race on April 29 with a time of 47.72.

The team of Paul Bruce, Jakob Michel, Anthony Mathis and Tirek Austin-Cave, pictured above, was one of only nine middle school teams from across the state who advanced to the championship. This is the first time a Rosa team has placed first in the Penn Relays.



Congratulations also go out to Cherry Hill High School East senior Aaron Groff, pictured above, who placed 7th in the 3,000-meter run at the Penn Relays with a time of 8:26.57.
