Summer Enrichment Opportunities Open to Wide Range of Ages

Two summer programs, one for rising 1st through 7th graders and one for rising 6th through 11th graders, are now accepting student registrations.

This is a 4-day, 14 hour tutorial workshop (28 hours if taking both Math and Verbal), will be held the weeks of August 1-4 and August 8-11. Session hours are 9 am - 12:30 pm, 1 pm - 4:30 pm, or 5 pm - 8:30 pm. We recommend that if you are taking both Math and Verbal, do not take them the same week.

The program is sponsored by the Cherry Hill Guidance Departments. Workshops will be held at Cherry Hill High Schools East and West. Enrollment will determine if courses run and where. Details and a registration form are available by clicking here.

The 2016 College Essay Tutorial will contain a maximum of 10-12 students who will complete all steps of the writing process (from prewriting through production of a final draft) to create a college essay. This 4-day, 13 hour tutorial workshop will be held the weeks of August 1-4 and 8-11. The session hours are 9 am - 12:15 pm, 1 pm - 4:15 pm, or 5 pm - 8:15 pm.
