A Special Meeting of the Lawnside Board of Education was called to order at 7:04 p.m. in Library of the Lawnside Public School, 426 Charleston Avenue. Board President Sabrina Forrest presided. Ms. Forrest announced that notice of the meeting was sent to the Courier Post, Record Breeze, Philadelphia Inquirer and the Lawnside Borough Clerk as required by statute.

Public Hearing on 2014-2015 Budget

The Superintendent presented a PowerPoint slideshow to report the district goals and school highlights for the current school year as well as outline the proposed enhancements contained in the 2014-2015 budget. The proposed enhancements were categorized as follows: Academic and Instructional Improvements, Technological Upgrades, Facility Renovations Enhancements, and Community Outreach Initiatives. The Board Secretary presented a slideshow to review all areas of the proposed spending plan for 2014-2015; the presentation included a comparison of the current year with that of the ensuing year.

Board Member Canute Gardiner entered during the presentation at 7:22 p.m., making 7 present, 2 absent.

The 2014-2015 budget that was approved by the Executive County Superintendent totaled \$8,858,621 and was categorized as follows:

The district received a 0.2% increase in state aid (\$7,880) equally awarded in two new categories — PARCC Readiness Aid and Per Pupil Growth Aid. The tax levy needed to support the Operating Budget for the ensuing year is \$4,063,082; this is \$79,669 more than the current school year and represents a 2% increase. The projected tax rate is \$1.949 per \$100 assessment, a 2¢ increase. This is the first tax rate increase since the 2010-2011 budget.
