*******FREE MEALS FOR 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR:*******

Due to the extension of the Government Policy (SSO) all students under the age of 18 are eligible to receive a breakfast and lunch at no charge through June, 2021.

Distribution of Free Meals Now Offers Full Week of Meals per Student on Mondays. The Cherry Hill Public Schools now distributes seven free meals per student to ALL CHERRY HILL STUDENTS (public, private and home-schooled). Families may pick up meals each Monday during the noon-2 pm pickup time or during the 4-6 pm pickup time at High Schools East and West. Each student will receive a week's worth of meals: 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches.

Food Pantries in our area
