COVID-19 Prevention Guidelines

Providing a safe environment is a partnership between parents/guardians and the school district. The CHPS has put into place many measures to keep our students and staff safe while they are in school. We ask that our parents and guardians help to prevent the spread of COVID, as well as other illnesses by:

- Reporting to the nurse if your child or any household member tests positive for COVID, or if they have an actual or suspected COVID exposure

- Alerting the school nurse about any planned travel to discuss the required post-quarantine guideline, prior to sending your child back to school
