

- Communicating information transparently with the students, families, staff members, and community.





Governor Murphy Lifts Mask Mandate





The Road Forward Committee Recommendation

The Road Forward Committee recommends that mask requirements in Cherry Hill Public Schools (grades K-12) to be based upon the COVID-19 Activity Level Index (CALI) score as reflected below.

CALI Report Level	Masking Requirement	
Green (Low Risk)	Optional	
Yellow (Moderate Risk)	Optional	
Orange (High Risk)	Optional	
Red (Very High Risk)	Required	

Please note that a federal mandate still requires all students, bus drivers and staff riding on school buses to be masked at all times during their time on the bus.

Masking may be required during field trips as per the venue's policies.
