

#### **REVISE ATTENDANCE AREA POLICY - 8110**

Middle School

Effective for the 2023-2024 school year, middle school open enrollment will cease as per Policy 5111.2 and students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be assigned to the middle schools as follows:

- a. Beck Middle School will receive students from James F. Cooper, Bret Harte, Joseph D. Sharp and Richard Stockton Elementary Schools.
- b. Carusi Middle School will receive students from Clara Barton, Joyce Kilmer, Kingston, A. Russell Knight and Thomas Paine Elementary Schools.
- c. Rosa Middle School will receive students from James Johnson, Horace Mann and Woodcrest Elementary Schools. (A. Russell Knight)
