Current Middle Level Schedule

- **Advisory is 35 minutes**
- **Periods are 52 minutes with a rotating 78 minute block once every four days. These periods are ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies.**
- **Day 1-4 rotating schedule**
- **World Language (French/Spanish) occur every day in 52 minute classes**
- **Physical Education/Special Area classes are 52 minutes and occur every other day**
- **Lunch is 26 minutes**

Positive Impacts

- **World Language classes are the same length as all other classes**
- **Maintains advisory, which is critical for the middle level model**

- **Physical Education/Special Area classes are 52 minutes and occur every other day**
- **Lunch is 26 minutes**

Value added with the 2024-2025 Proposed Middle School Schedule-Revisions

- Seven additional minutes to Advisory for greater supports with the music programs, Social Emotional Learning, Character Education, and Advisory supports
- The revisions still allow for all students to receive a choice of world languages (French/Spanish) every day
- The schedule is more conducive when addressing staff shortages
- 26 minutes to support intervention. There will be opportunities for all students to receive enrichment during the Day 1-4 cycle.
- The schedule revisions are cost neutral
- The schedule revisions are standardized but also allow for the necessary variance needed school to school

Next Steps

- Research (I&E and Advisory). Includes site visits to other schools and investigating training for I&E delivery
- Curriculum teams for Advisory and I&E will be developed this spring



Next Steps

- Communication with staff, students, and families
- Scheduling teams will meet with our Technology department to properly merge the proposed schedule within the Genesis Student Management System
- Full implementation will commence at the start of the 2024-2025 school year
