



SCHOOL BUS RULES

ALLEN PARK PUBLIC SCHOOLS

an uncompromising commitment to excellence

- NO Fighting or name calling
- NO eating, chewing or spitting on the bus (gum, candy, drinks, etc.)
- NO using profanity or being disrespectful
- NO standing while the bus is in motion
- NO horse play or moving seat once the bus departs
- NO cell phone use, photos or video taking: All electronics and toys are to stay within the student's backpack during the bus ride
- NO Throwing objects inside or outside the bus
- NO yelling or arms out the window
- NO feet in the aisles, face front at all times
- NO Screaming or loud talking
- NO spraying perfume, hairspray etc.
- Please keep quiet during railroad crossing
- Parents/guardians are responsible for the student's safety to and from the bus stop
- Kindergarten students must be picked up by a parent or guardian at the bus stop
- Students need to arrive at their bus stop at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled pick up times
- Be mindful: Don't touch the emergency door handle and keep the bus clean. Put trash in the containers provided and don't damage the bus
- Students are not to approach the bus until it has come to a complete stop and the driver signals them to board the bus. Students must stay out of the school bus "Danger Zone". The "Danger Zone" is the area 10 feet around ALL sides of the bus.
- Damaging the bus in anyway (including puncturing/tearing/writing on the seats) – parents/guardians will be monetarily responsible for any damage done to a bus

NOTE: Any violation may result in a bus discipline notice being sent to the student's parent/guardian and school.

Failure to abide by the bus rider rules and expectations may result in a busing suspension and/or expulsion from the bus.
