We plan to start the evening with a brief presentation from the Administration held in the auditorium and then have parents follow their student's class schedule for an abbreviated school day. Nurse's Notes From the Student Health Office

With flu season upon us, it is important to keep our

students healthy. It is important to know the difference between cold and flu. Common symptoms of the flu include high fever, severe headache, muscle and body aches, chills, sore throat, exhaustion and dry cough. Children may also have nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea. Often cold symptoms come on gradually and they include stuffy nose, sneezing, sore throat and hacking cough.

Simple Steps Keeping Students Healthy According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the best way to prevent your child from getting the flu is to take him/her/them to get a flu vaccine.

Talk to your child about practicing good health habits, such as:

- Washing hands frequently with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds
- Covering mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing-preferably into the inside of the elbow or with a tissue and disposing of the tissue immediately into the trash
- Avoiding sharing drinks, water bottles, eating utensils and cell phones
- Avoiding touching their eyes, nose, and mouth

You can help prevent the flu from spreading at home by disinfecting frequently touched surfaces, toys, and other commonly shared items.

You can prevent spreading illness to others by keeping your sick children home from school until they have been without fever for 24 hours. It is important for your sick child to get rest and drink plenty of fluids.

Some children may benefit from an antiviral medication, which can be prescribed by a doctor to help lessen the number of days that a child is sick with the virus. To be effective, antiviral medication should be taken within 12-48 hours after the flu symptoms begin. A doctor may also prescribe the antiviral to prevent the child from getting the flu; if taken within the first 12-48 hours of exposure to the flu virus there is an 89 percent chance the medication will keep him/her from getting sick.

- **Please keep your students home if they have had any of the following symptoms:
- Fever (100.0° Fahrenheit or higher), chills, or shaking chills
- · Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- · New loss of taste or smell
- · Muscle or body aches
- · Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
- · Sore throat, when in combination with other symptoms
- · Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea when in combination with other symptoms
- · Headache when in combination with other symptoms
- · Fatigue, when in combination with other symptoms
- · Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies) when in combination with other symptoms

**If your child develops any of the above symptoms at school, <u>you may be contacted to pick them up.</u>

Mandated Health Screenings

Our school nurses oversee the mandated universal health screening program as required by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. Screenings are supervised by the school nurse and your child's privacy will be respected at all times. Screenings will take place over the next few months and are as follows:

Hearing grades K - 3, 7 & 10 Vision grades Preschool, K - 5, 7 & 10 Stereopsis (binocular vision) gr K - 3 Postural screening grades 5 - 9. Height/Weight/BMI grades 1, 4, 7, and 10

The results will be documented in the student Health Record and provided in aggregate form to the MDPH according to the regulations.

Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) grades 7 & 9. The SBIRT protocol facilitates a one-on-one conversation between the student and a school nurse or counselor in an effort to prevent or at least delay the start of using harmful substances, such as alcohol and marijuana. This program focuses on reinforcing healthy decisions and addressing concerning behaviors around substance use with the goal of improving health, safety and success in school. SBIRT screening results will not be included in your child's school record.



Preregistration for the clinic is through Walgreens, but is not required. All participants must wait 15 minutes postadministration for observation.

Middle School Ski & Snowboard Club



We are excited to bring back the South Hadley Ski & Snowboard Club for it's 2nd year. This program is open to those currently in Grade 5-8 that are South Hadley residents or attend Michael E. Smith Middle School. Registrations for the program open October 15th and run through November 15th or when the program fills, whichever comes first.

SPACE IS LIMITED - SPOTS ARE FILLED ON A FIRST COME BASIS (50 MAXIMUM PARTIPANTS)

*Please note that this program is designed for independent skiing/snowboarding. When your students participate in lessons, they will have an instructor accompanying them. However, once the lesson ends, students are responsible for their own activities on the mountain. While we will have chaperones skiing and monitoring the area, it is important to clarify that they will not be skiing alongside the participants. The chaperones are assigned to perform check-ins and ensure the safety of the students.

The program will take place on Wednesday nights for six weeks (weather dependent) at Bousquet Mountain. January 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th and February 5th & 12th.

A deposit of \$226 will be due by November 15th
