Applications for the \$500.00 Dorothy Walker Beach Memorial Scholarship are available at all high schools in Miami County or from Piqua-Lewis Boyer Chapter NSDAR.

Mrs. Beach served the Piqua Chapter NSDAR as Regent during the years 1973-1976. She died in 1988, and left a bequest to the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution for the purpose of establishing a college scholarship for an outstanding student in a Miami County senior high school each year. An applicant may pursue his/her degree in any field of study.

The recipient will be honored by the Piqua-Lewis Boyer Chapter at their Awards Tea on February 8, 2025. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the college or university of the recipient's choice in mid-year 2025. If, for any reason, the recipient does not enter college during the 2025-2026 academic year, the scholarship money will be forfeited. The scholarship money will also be forfeited if the recipient enters a military academy.

Applicants do NOT have to be related to a DAR member or descended from a person who participated in the Revolutionary War. In order to be considered for the scholarship, an applicant:

***Must graduate from a Miami County high school in 2025**

***Must be admitted by an accredited college or university and plan to begin his/her studies during the 2025-2026 academic year.**

The scholarship is awarded based on academic record, test results, character, leadership qualities and participation in extracurricular activities and need.
