Middle School Ski and Snowboard Club

Stillwater Community Education partners with Afton Alps every year to provide an opportunity for non-competitive winter recreation. The Ski and Snowboard Club will travel to Afton Alps six times between January and March. A school bus will transport students to Afton Alps and back to Stillwater Middle School and Oak-Land Middle School. Students are provided with four hours of skiing/snowboarding time each day.

Time: 3-8 p.m. (3:30-7:30 p.m. at Afton Alps)

Transportation: Buses will leave the schools at 3 p.m. and return at 8 p.m. **Parents must pick up students at 8 p.m.** Students do not have access to a phone. Students can be picked up at Afton Alps if a note is provided by a parent/guardian before leaving the school at 3 p.m.

Cost: Non-Season Pass Holders: \$335.00 includes six lift tickets, transportation and supervision
Season Pass Holders: \$105.00 includes bus transportation and supervision

Equipment Rental: Equipment rental (\$225/season) and lockers are available through Afton Alps. The form must be filled out and returned to Afton Alps each session.

Equipment Storage: Equipment at SMS can be stored in the athletic storage room located next to the boy's locker room. Equipment at OMS can be stored in the auditorium. This area will be open from 7:30-a.m. and 2:30-3 p.m. Equipment will not be stored in the main office. Bags, extra equipment, etc. must be stored in lockers (for purchase) at Afton Alps. Afton Alps does not allow bags and equipment to be left unattended around the chalet.

Food: Food is NOT provided. Please pack a bag dinner or send money with your student.

Injuries:

Injured skiers are taken to the first aid building by the Ski Patrol. The Ski Club Supervisor is notified and the Supervisor will call the parent/guardian. Parent/Guardian must decide on the next step:

- Wait and ride the bus as normal
- Wait at Afton Alps for the parent/emergency contact to pick student up
- Call for ambulance transportation to the hospital

Cancellations:

Cancellations are not made often. If Ski Club is canceled, announcements will be made to the students. Cancellations will also be placed on the SMS website. If canceled, students are expected to catch their normal bus home OR find a ride. We will make every effort to reschedule a canceled date. If rescheduling is not possible, we will refund lift tickets for that day.

Refunds:

There are no refunds for missed days or transportation. A refund will only be issued if a date is canceled and not rescheduled.

Expectations:

Students are held to the same expectations during Ski Club as they are during the school day. The Student Handbook goes into detail about these expectations. The Student Handbook is available on the school's webpage. Please be familiar with the expectations in this book. The Supervisor and Principal will use the Student Handbook as a guideline for any student that misbehaves, discriminates, bullies, harasses, vandalizes, is caught with a weapon, and /or is caught using or in possession of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. Any of these behavior violations are grounds for dismissal from Ski club without a refund.

Registration:
