- Increased threats on social media- More of an issue in middle school and high school. •
- Community must make sure they report it instead of reposting, so we don't cause panic and fear. •
- Emphasis is on making sure people are alerting the authorities and schools when they notice • something, so we are taking care of any issues immediately.
- Must emphasize with all the students that this is serious. •
- This will not be taken lightly. •
