Homecoming Parade Update:

Homecoming Parade rescheduled to 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 10th.

The 2024 Wyoming High School Homecoming Parade has been rescheduled to 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 10. Though the parade usually takes place at 6 p.m., this earlier time accommodates previously scheduled student events and gives our high school students a better opportunity to be part of the rescheduled festivities.

Parade lineup will start at 3:45 p.m. on Worthington Avenue.

At 4:30 p.m., the parade route will be:

North on Springfield Pike from Worthington Avenue, East on Chestnut Avenue, South on Burns Avenue, West on Pendery Avenue, Ending at Wyoming High School. Gates open for the home football game vs. Mariemont at 6 p.m.; kickoff is at 7 p.m. Music and games will be available for Wyoming High School students between the completion of the parade and when gates open.

The Wyoming High School Homecoming Parade is open to Wyoming High School students, Wyoming City Schools support organizations, and area youth programs. <u>Support organizations and area youth programs that would like to participate are asked to complete this application by Tuesday, October 8</u>.

SENIORS:

• **SENIOR CHECK-IN MEETING.** We are wrapping up our Senior Check-In meetings and they have been great! We have met with more than half of the senior class and have enjoyed learning about your plans after high school and navigating you through the college application process. If you have not met with your college/career counselor to discuss your plans after high school, this needs to happen as soon as possible, but no later than **November 1st. TESTING

- PSAT/ED-OPTION DAY is October 16th. On this day, each grade level will participate in a
 different educational experience related to college and career. For many of our students,
 this is the day they will take the PSAT to assess their current level of college readiness.
 Other students will have the option to engage in an activity that will provide them with
 deeper insight about themselves and/or their chosen career path.
 - 9th Grade- YouScience assessment and activity (must bring school Chromebook). Students will be dismissed at 11:00 a.m.
 - 10th Grade- REQUIRED Digital PSAT (must bring school Chromebook). Students will be dismissed at 11:00 a.m.
 - 11th Grade- OPTIONAL Digital PSAT (must bring school Chromebook); or Ed-Option experience (college visit, service/volunteer, or job shadow). Only juniors taking the PSAT should report to school. Students will be dismissed at 11:00 a.m.
 - o 12th Grade- Ed-Option experience. Seniors do not report to school.
