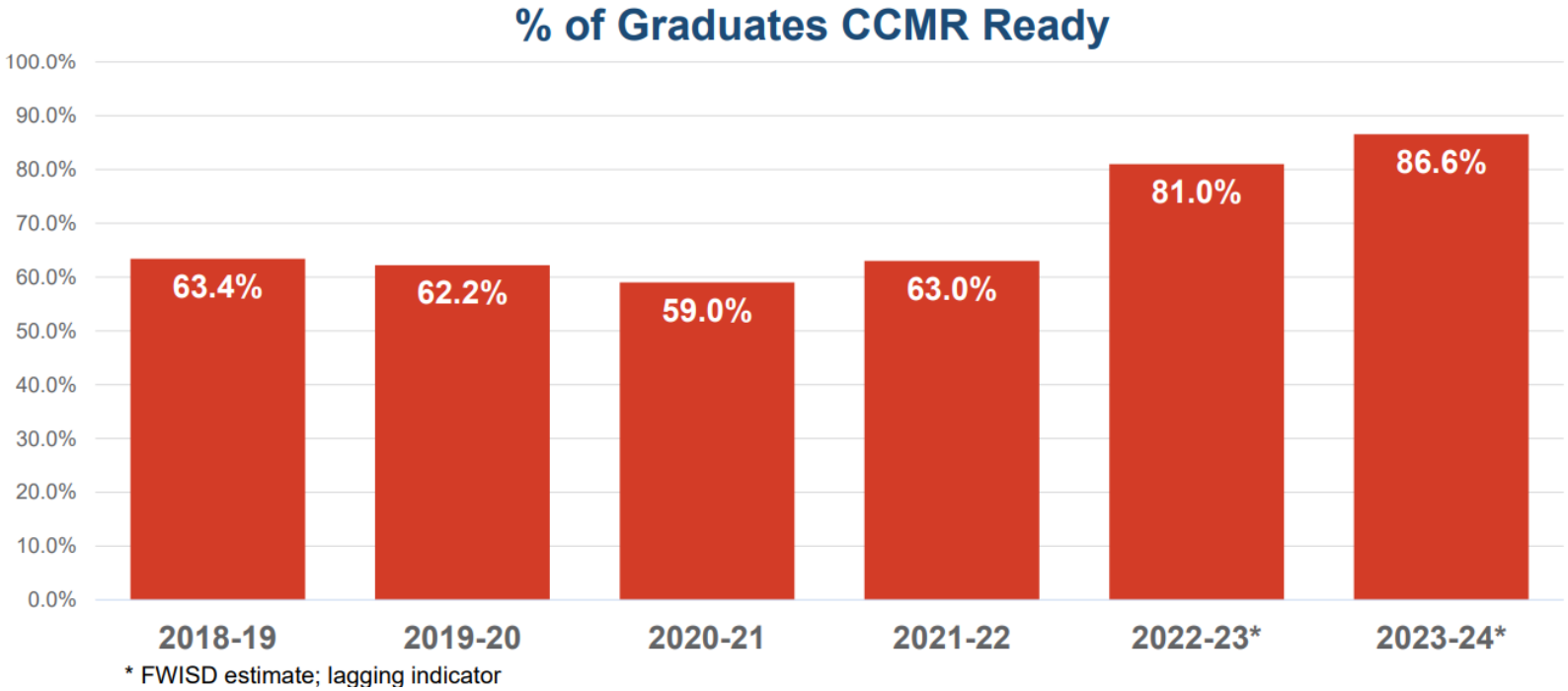

# CCMR Completer Status

Students at FWISD are achieving higher rates of CCMR readiness over the last two years.

# CCMR Accountability Calculations

## Domain 1: Student Achievement (SA)

### **CCMR- 40%**

- based on lagging data from previous year

### **STAAR- 40%**

- based on STAAR assessments passing rates

### **Graduation Rate- 20%**

- based on graduation rate over four, five, or six year graduation rate (lagging data)

## Domain 2: School Progress (SP)

Based on IIA or IIB (whichever is higher)= 100% Domain 2 score

### **IIA- ACADEMIC GROWTH**

Percentage of students who grew at least one year academically via STAAR results

### **IIB- RELATIVE PERFORMANCE**

An average of STAAR and CCMR scores of Domain 1 compared to districts with similar percentages of student economically disadvantaged

## Domain 3: Closing Gaps (CG)

### **Academic Achievement- 50%**

- Percentage of students in targeted groups who meet/exceed the Meets level of performance in ELAR and Math

### **CCMR- 30%**

- Percentage of prior year annual graduates plus students in grade 12 that did not graduate who met CCMR indicator

### **Four-Year Federal Graduation- 10%**

- Percentage of students who graduated in a four year period

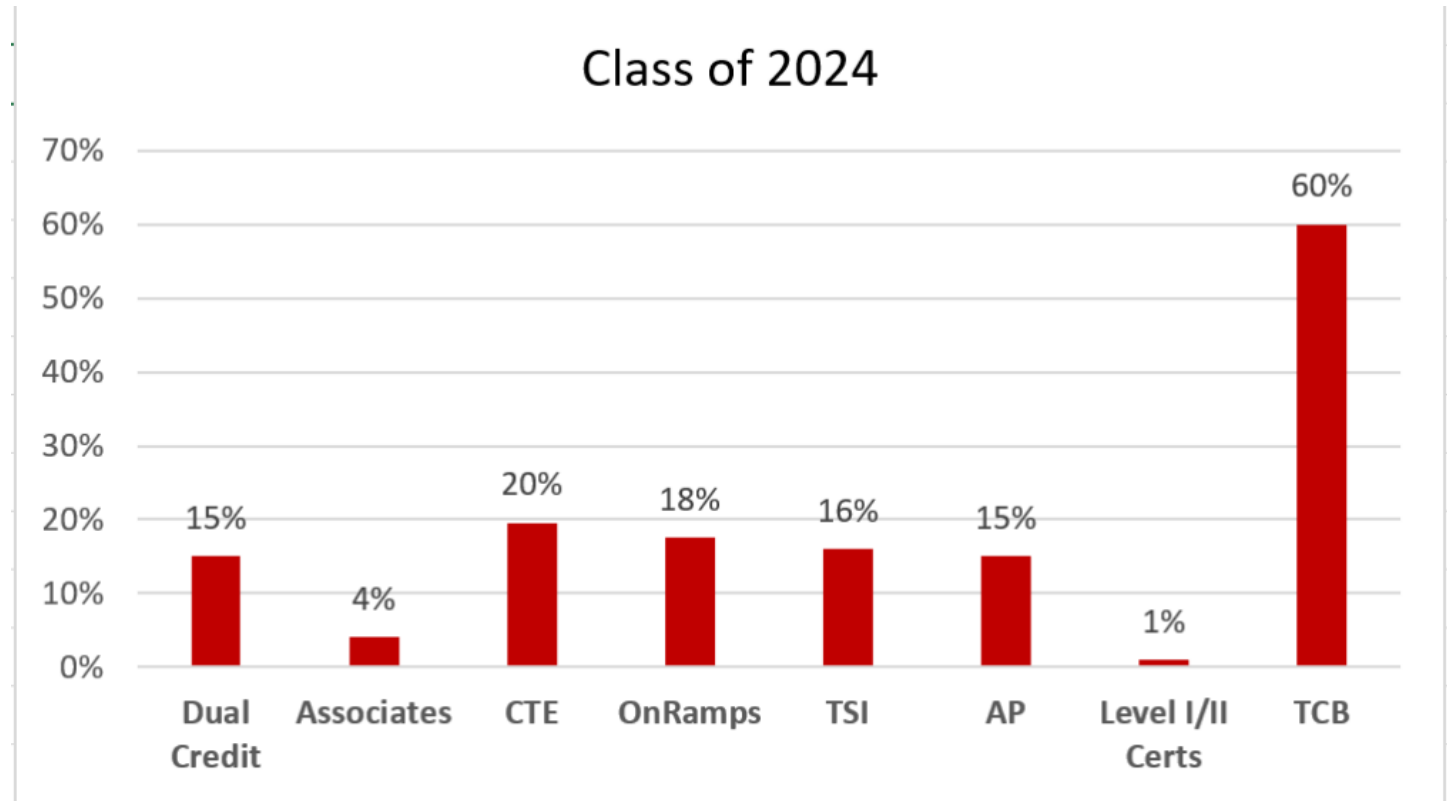
### **English Language Proficiency- 10%**

- Emergent Bilingual student proficiency in English as measured by TELPAS

**Final Calculation = (Greater of SA or SP) x 70% + (CG) x 30%**

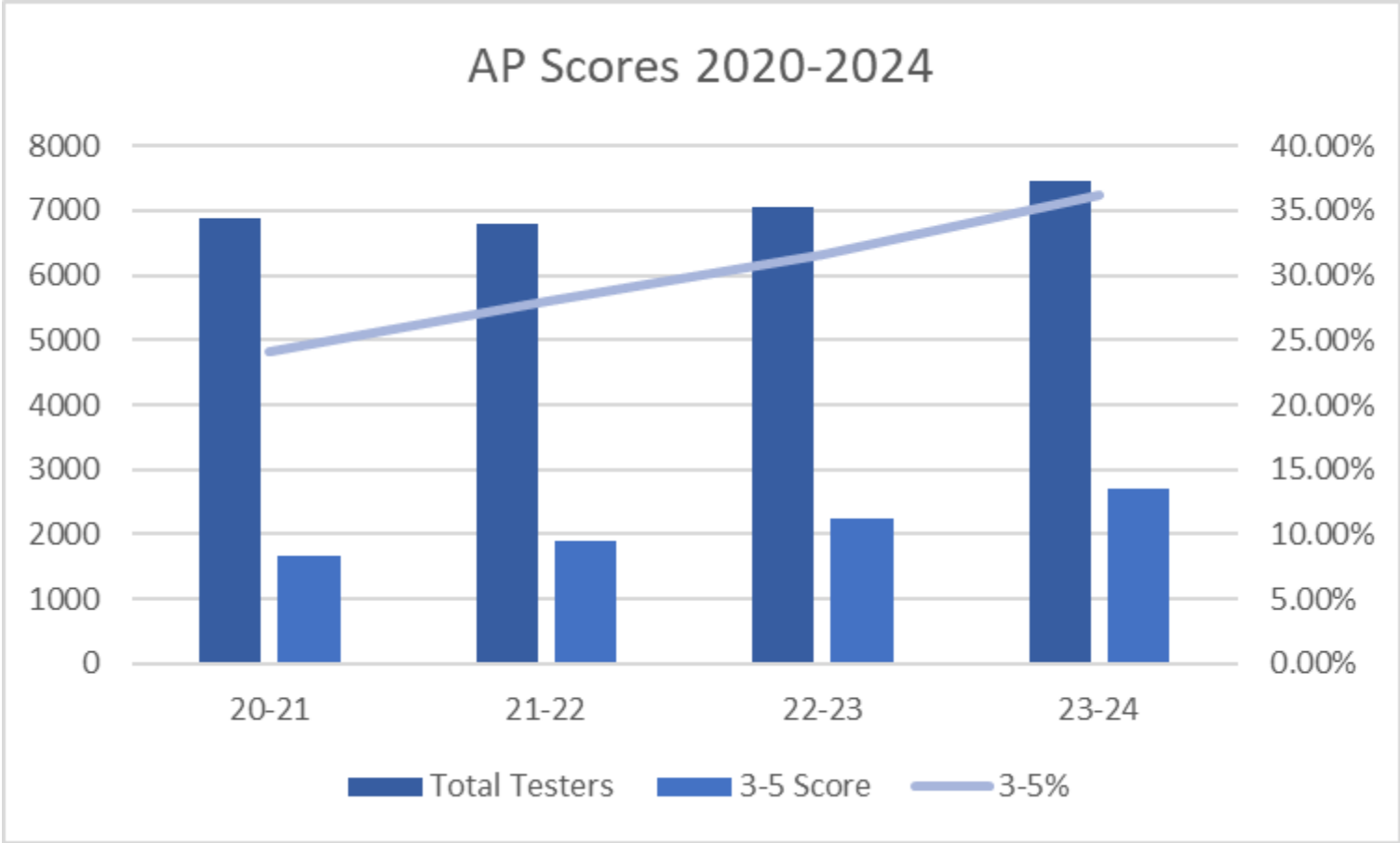

FWISD is increasing participation and success for every student group through dual credit opportunities.

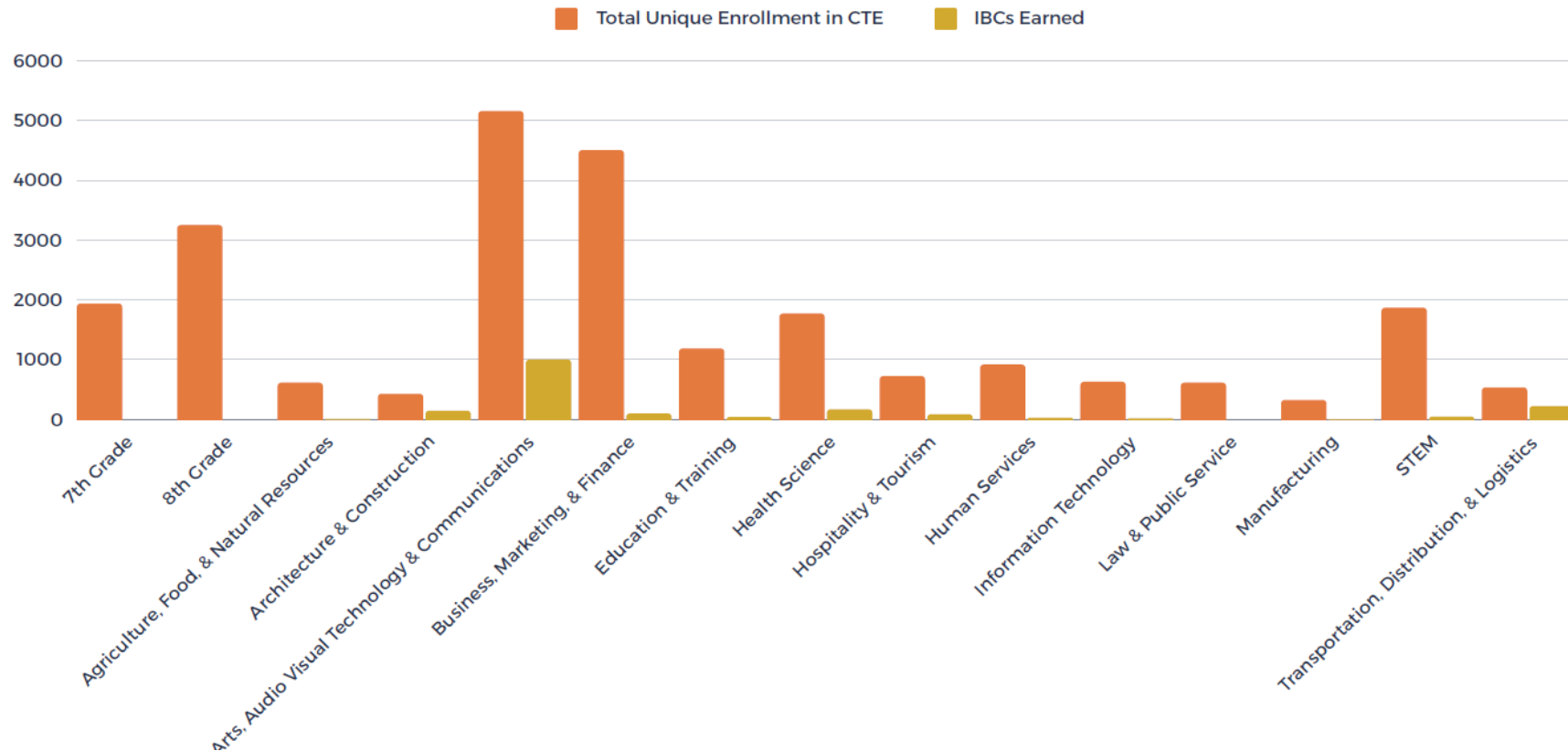

# Outcomes Based Measures

Outcomes Based Measures (OBM) are how TEA evaluates an early college high school (both ECHS and P-TECH). The OBMs are measured in Access, Attainment, and Achievement.

Access is related to the percentage of At-Risk students in the program

Achievement is related to EOC scores, TSIA2 scores, graduation rate, & CTE program status.

Attainment is related to the earning of college hours, Associate's degree, and IBC, as well as persistence



# P-TECH Program Spotlight

## North Side High School P-TECH

- 137 students
- Eco Dis- 87.9%
- EB- 46.2%
- At Risk - 86.3%

North Side P-TECH was showcased by Educate Texas for their excellent results in September 2024.

- Students earned 10 Associate Degrees in the 23/24 school year.
- Certified Nursing Industry-Based Certification:
  - 77% (class of 24)
  - 83% (class of 25)
- On track to earn the level of Distinction (highest rating) from TEA for Access, Attainment, and Achievement.
