## KNOW WHAT OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE FOR HEALTH INSURANCE

### How Children Qualify for Medicaid:

- Be under Age 19 and live in Alabama
- Be a U.S. citizen or be in satisfactory immigration status according to agency rules
- Meet income requirements (see chart below)
- If the child does not qualify for Medicaid due to income, the application will be processed for the ALL Kids program



## FOOD SECURITY

The Food Assistance Division administers the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) in Alabama.

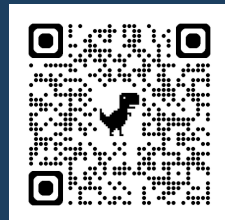

MyDHR is the ONLY website where you can apply for Food Assistance online. Applications for the Food Assistance Program are also available in all county DHR offices.

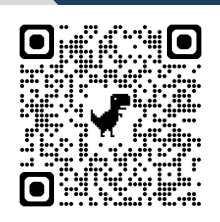
