Your survey feedback has helped the Facilities Planning Committee narrow down 5 key facilities improvements that would cost an estimated \$44/month for the average owner of a \$750,000 home in Hockinson.



Build a Second Elementary School

Address overcrowding issues at HHES, the largest elementary school by student population in Clark County (currently 924 students).



Replace Track & Install Synthetic Turf Field at HHS

The school's aging track and grass field are expensive to maintain and need to be replaced. A turf field can be used year-round for PE, athletics, marching band, and community recreation.



Covered Outdoor Area at HMS

An outdoor cover protects students from the elements during lunch, recess, and athletic practices.



School Safety Improvements at HHES, HMS & HHS

There is currently no capability to instantly secure exterior doors during a lockdown at HHES. Adding automatic campus lockdown functionality and emergency messaging in classrooms will improve safety at all HSD schools.



Add Job Readiness Education Building at HHS

The building would be a hands-on space for students to explore job readiness skills in Career & Technical Education classes.
