




Key features

- Flexibility to go to almost any doctor or hospital.
- No requirement to have a primary care doctor.
- No referral needed to see a specialist.



Something to think about

You'll pay less if you choose doctors and facilities in your plan's network.







Know your health plan terms



Copay

A set fee that you pay at a doctor's visit or when picking up medicine.



Coinsurance

Your share of the costs for covered healthcare services after you've met your deductible.



Deductible

A set amount of money you must pay each year for covered healthcare services before your health plan shares the costs.



Out-of-pocket limit

The maximum amount you pay for covered services each year. Once you reach that limit, our plan covers the rest. Your copays, deductible, and coinsurance count toward your out-of-pocket limit.



Predictable out-of-pocket costs: Access+ HMO Plans

With this plan, your primary care physician (PCP) coordinates all your care and refers you to specialists and hospitals within their medical group or Independent Practice Association (IPA).



Plan highlights

- → Each member of your family must select a PCP from our broad HMO network and may choose a different physician and medical group/IPA.
- → No deductible; only fixed copayments for most covered services like doctor visits, urgent care, and emergency care.
- → Access to virtual health care with Teladoc Health's doctors and mental health professionals who can treat many medical and mental health issues.
- → Mental health benefits for help with depression, mental illness, and alcohol or substance use disorder.
- → Features The Away From Home Care program, which offers family members living outside California students, workers on long-distance assignments, etc. access to medical care in select states across the country. (Availability varies by state.)





Urgent Care: Access+ HMO

When experiencing an illness or injury that is serious, but not an emergency, consider visiting an urgent care center to receive care that is typically faster and costs less than an emergency room visit.

Urgent Care Centers can treat many conditions such as:

- → Cough, sore throat, respiratory infections
- → Back pain, body aches, earaches
- → Colds, sinus infections, allergies
- → Eye irritation, swelling or pain
- → Sprains or muscle strains
- Rashes, minor cuts. scrapes
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

Note: HMO members must make sure their urgent care center is affiliated with their primary care physician and medical group.






How to find your PCP's ID number: Access+ HMO


