- Board Members shared information regarding site visits, committee reports and other community related activities.

Superintendent's Report

- MUSD Update: Superintendent Hays reported on the following: the District's unduplicated pupil count; the District's month 1 attendance rate; completion of the CMS library renovations; solar power being generated at Arroyo West, the DO and Campus Canyon will begin any day; leadership attended Incident Command System training at the VCOE; congratulated Juan Pablo Herrera as the recipient of the City of Moorpark Hispanic Heritage Month proclamation; thanked and congratulated MHS teachers, students and staff for the wonderful Sabor Latino festival to celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month; newly implemented in-house LiveScan; new science materials in every grade level; new financial literacy supplemental curriculum for the middle school IDEA class; instructional services leadership team presenting at the CAL Assessment Conference; middle school intramural basketball is commencing; and a status update on the enforcement of the District's cell phone policy, including positive feedback from teachers who have seen an increase in student engagement.
