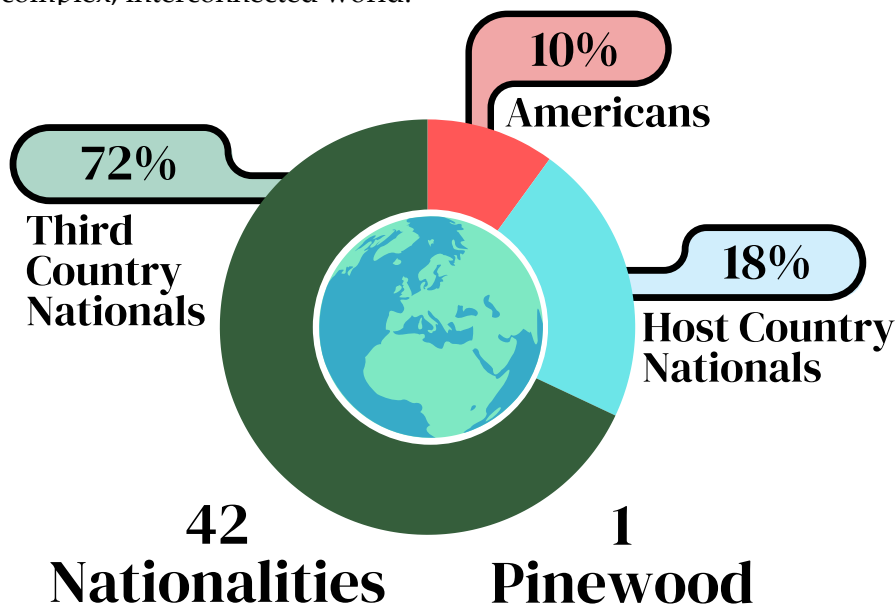


PINEWOOD STUDENTS

OUR CURRICULUM

Advanced Placement® Curriculum

Pinewood offers a rigorous AP Curriculum, including the Capstone Diploma, designed to challenge and prepare students for college-level academics. 50% of our students scored a 4 or 5 in their 2023-24 exams, and 67% reached a passing score. Our dedicated AP teachers provide personalized support to ensure each student's success, helping them excel in both exams and coursework.

IB Diploma Program

Our school offers a comprehensive IB Curriculum that nurtures well-rounded, globally-minded students prepared for the challenges of higher education and beyond. One out of four of our students earned 35 to 39 in their 2023-24 exams. Our skilled IB educators guide students through a challenging and rewarding academic journey, fostering both personal and academic growth.

AP Exams

The 2023-2024 school year was the pilot year for AP courses at Pinewood High School, starting with 2 AP courses.

Following a successful year with increasing student interest, Pinewood added 10 AP courses for the 2024-2025 school year.
