If you are unable to attend August 15, your student's packet will be available the first day of school. Students unable to attend will also have the opportunity to get their school picture taken during picture retakes.

Lastly, please note that all students will receive their personal learning devices on Friday, August 23d during the school day. All returning students must return their old devices on this day to receive their new device.

MEDICATION POLICY

Medication may not be taken at school unless a completed authorization form is on file in the main office. This policy includes both prescribed and non-prescribed medication.. Also, please be aware that the school does not provide any medications, i.e., aspirin or Tylenol. Please plan to drop off any medication to Shruti Gross in the main office during Kick Start. You must have completed paperwork for all medication. Medication Form needed.

FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

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Kinawa participates in the Weekend Survival Kits program which provides GROCERIES OVER THE WEEKEND, so families can focus more on other necessities.

Weekend Survival Kits provides supplemental kits of food to children at school every other Friday so they can have nutritious food during the weekend.

If you have multiple children, you are eligible to receive multiple kits. All names will remain confidential.

If you will be dropping your child off in the morning or picking them up, please make sure you use the large parking lot on the east side of Kinawa. The loop in front of the school as well as the bus lane to the West of the school cannot be used for student drop off or pick up.
