Parent and Family Engagement Plan

What is Title I?

Stonewall Tell Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. The Title I program must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP).

What is it?

The plan describes how Stonewall Tell Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. How is it revised?

Stonewall Tell Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.
