Teacher Recommendation

The internship program, offered by Strasburg High School and participating employers, is designed to provide students with practical, hands-on experience. Throughout the program, interns will have the opportunity to collaborate with experienced professionals, explore their interests, and develop essential skills for future career success.

Program Objectives:

1. Gain practical experience in industry
2. Develop professional skills such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, and time management.
3. Receive mentorship and guidance from experienced professionals in the field.
4. Build a professional network and establish connections for future career opportunities.

Students will meet with the teacher one day a week and complete at least 10 hours of work a week.

Managers of employees will be surveyed to discuss the students work and attendance, and grades will be based on that survey. This class is worth 2.0 elective credits.

Teacher's Assistant
*****Elective Credit**

Grades 11 - 12
Requires Administration Approval

Teacher's Assistant gives students the opportunity to work with a teacher within the district. This is a pass/fail class and eligibility to participate depends on the student's overall grades and attendance. The administration will decide which teacher the student will work with. Grades for this class are based solely on attendance. This class is worth 1.0 elective credits.

Students must be in good academic standing for graduating on time from SHS to qualify to take classes from Pickens Tech or Morgan Community College.

Pickens Tech - Can only be taken if a student is on track to graduate and meets Pickens Tech's requirements. They will also have to win a slot in Pickens Tech's lottery.
