Welcome - Beginning of the year information

- Enrollment – 1998 students, 2100 at the beginning of the year
- Cell phones/ dress code – report from Vance, Hancock, Fletcher that it is a success. The students are more engaged in learning and following the policy in every class. Leanne – girls feel targeted because the bra straps are showing. Mr. Vance will address the dress code policy in his next ILT meeting.
- Town Hall Meetings
- Safety –
 - Police officers are not supposed to be in their offices, and they write weekly reports on the safety concerns we need to address.
 - Teacher doors are shut during class, and when left open, admin walks around and closes the doors. Mr. Hubbard – walks the building for security, and his students check the exterior doors between classes.
 - Centegix badges and alerts in the classroom with voice commands are used at Creekview.
 - We had a code red drill last week, and the system works properly. Hancock reiterated that the voice commands were clear so the students could hear and understand.
- Academics
 - 2023-24 Review (School Profile) – Report from Mrs. Sikes on Creekview Academic Areas was sent out to parents in the weekly email from Mrs. Garriques.
 - SAT – Number 1 in all areas, EOC was not on the top, but many variables were involved, and AP Science, Pre-Calculus, and Art had 100% pass rates.
 - Graduation rate went up. Ms. Chastain's graduation coach worked with students, and it is no longer funded, but we are using a teacher allotment to fund the position part-time due to the success we have seen from the position.

- PSAT Day and Early Release – October 30th 9th and 10th grade, digital day for juniors and seniors. Early release for 9th and 10th grade students.
- Extracurricular
 - Start of the year – Football 4 and 2, 2 and 1 in the region, softball 15 -7 8 – 0 region 3rd place, chorus performing at KSU, Band competition Monday, Band is performing at Grayson Saturday, One Act Play is moved to the 15ht and 16th. Volleyball 17 and 17, 3 and 3 in region
