MORE THAN JUST ICE

Ice year round



The original ice arena, built in October 1997, has hosted Olympic Speed Skating trials and various hockey and skating events for over 27 years. Maintaining the ice year-round requires significant time, expertise, funding, and commitment.

The Facility Maintenance Technicians are all certified in driving the ice resurfacer and go through training each year to maintain the ice quality. At the heart of this system are chillers, which work alongside compressors to circulate a coolant, usually a mix of brine or glycol, through pipes embedded in the rink floor. A substantial amount of electricity is needed to power these systems, especially the chillers and compressors, ensuring consistent cooling.





The ice thickness must be regularly maintained, typically around 1-2 inches for recreational use, which is managed by flooding the rink with water and then using specialized equipment to freeze it in thin layers. The process of watering the ice also smooths out imperfections.

Greenheck Turner Community Center offers many opportunities for public ice skating and skate rentals in a variety of sizes. Ice Helpers are available to push for those who need extra balance help. Throughout the year, holiday skates, moonlight skates, and camps are available for youth. Skaters from Everest Youth Hockey, Storm Hockey, Blaze Hockey, Timberline Figure Skating, Cyclones Hockey and D.C. Everest Hockey skate year round.

In order to maintain ice year round, the ice is cooled and chilled by four large compressors. Maintaining this balance ensures a safe, smooth, and durable skating surface for public use.




