

**San Pasqual Union School District
School Site Council Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, May 7, 2024, at 3:30pm**

Meeting called to order at 3:30 pm.

Members Legge-Beekman, Timpe, Burroughs, Graves, Dussia, Clark, and Grassy were present.

Members Zdunich and Mohktari arrived after Agenda and minutes vote. (3:36)

Members Vitale, Cutchin and Lopez were not present.

Guests were welcomed and the pledge of allegiance recited.

Hearing of the public. No comments were shared.

Legge motioned to approve the current agenda and minutes from the 2/5/24 meeting. Burroughs seconded the motion. Motion carried 6/0

Mr. Burroughs advised that the Governing Board approved the Comprehensive School Safety Plan, the School Accountability Report Card, and the Local Control Accountability Plan, as recommended by SSC.

Mr. Burroughs also provided updates on the District review committee recommendations

- District Review Committee recommendations
 - The Governing Board followed SSC recommendations regarding library materials.
 - The Governing Board also followed CSBA's recommended updates to Board policy regarding challenged books. Among those changes, for materials that have been reviewed by the District (i.e., the recently challenged books), there is a 12-month waiting period before the materials can be reconsidered.
 - Per the Governing Board's request, Mr. Burroughs and Mrs. Carroll created a library inventory that describes the number of books on racial topics (i.e., civil rights, African-American, etc) and their correlation to student enrollment. Mr. Burroughs shared data with SSC.
 - Team discussed the accuracy of the numbers and labeled groupings.

Review and Discussion of Board Goals and LCAP Draft

- Board Goals
 - Mr. Burroughs shared the current version of draft board goals and how those may result in action items for next year. Some topics include:
 - Kagan training for staff

- Disparity achievement between EL and non-EL students. Draft goal is to shrink this gap.
 - Board Goals and LCAP
 - Member Timpe would like the opportunity to add input into LCAP. Mr. Burroughs suggests that he and any other member's comments should be submitted prior to Board Meeting on 5/14/2024
 - Legge - Mrs. Legge suggests that the "resilience" metric includes more than just student feedback. Mr. Burroughs will research CA Healthy Kids questions to see if comparable data exists and can be included for parents and staff.

Superintendent Report

- Curriculum - TK-5th Social Studies Adoption
 - 4 on state-approved list, we vetting 3 of those:
 - Studies Weekly
 - Pearson Scott Foresman - My World Interactive
 - McGraw-Hill - Impact
 - Timpe would like to see vertical alignment down to TK.
 - The McGraw-Hill option provides the best TK-8th grade alignment, teachers on committee currently leaning toward Studies Weekly
- Kagan
 - Structured classroom activities help students work in a structured environment where they learn to work together. Teaches teachers on how to use the structure.
 - Michalski and Johnson went to training in February, and learned and grew tremendously as educators.
 - Timpe - Very useful for MS as well. Using it daily. The engagements using the systems cut down on behaviors and wasted time
 - Dussia - How would this get deployed in a school?
 - The initial is training for all teachers during back-to-school, then during PD day in Nov, and Thursday PD sessions.
 - Looking at grades using about 3 "go to" strategies
