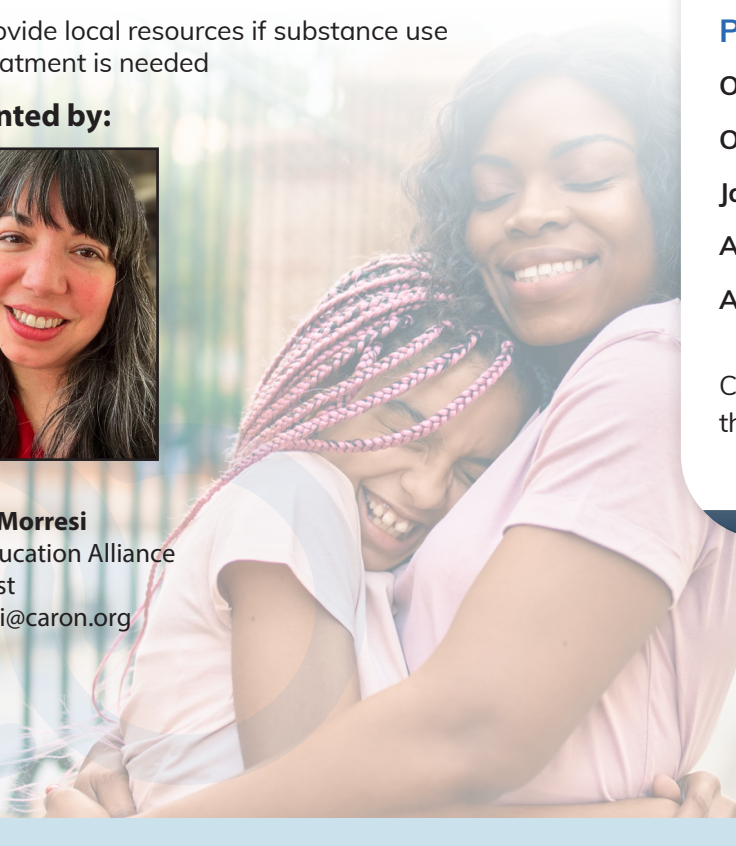
PROGRAM OBJECTIVES
