Principal's Report Agenda Item 6.1

This past Thursday, Tech Campus hosted its annual Awards Night at Grayslake North's Fieldhouse. At this event, Tech Campus is able to showcase students that participated in SkillsUSA, National Technical Honor Society, were student of the program, and received scholarships or other CTE related awards. We had over 200 participants involved in our Awards Night and we were able to award the Tech Campus Student of the Year Award. This is our most prestigious award at Tech Campus and comes with a \$750 scholarship for the student to continue there education. Automotive Instructor, Jack Wilson was named a LifeChanger of the Year in front of hundreds of students and parents at Thursday's event. Mr. Wilson was presented with a \$3,000 prize and plans to split it with the Tech Campus.

Associate Principal Report

86% of FY2023 CTEI funds have been received from the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE). 51% of Perkins funds have been allocated through April 2023. Schools will begin the process of submitting grant proposals for FY23. We are waiting on guidance and allotments from ISBE in order to proceed with the application process. The state usually notifies regions of funds by May 1.

The Lake County Area Vocational System will make all additions, changes and deletions to courses in the ISCS system so accurate data can be collected in SIS. The enrollments will be calculated towards FY23 grant allocations. The final deadline for all data is June 30, 2023.

Student awards night will be done Thursday May 4, 2023 at the Grayslake North Fieldhouse. We are excited to celebrate the students in person. Students being recognized include National Technical Honors Society, Program Student of the Year, SkillsUSA Competitors, and Tech Campus Student of the Year,

The CCPEC has been working with member schools on how to implement at least on pathway endorsement starting for SY24 if they want to start. However, ISBE is in the process of putting the application for pathway endorsements into IWAS. This should be ready in late August or early September. The CCPEC has also increased the number of business partnerships with the region immensely. This includes businesses where students can potentially do work-based learning experiences.
